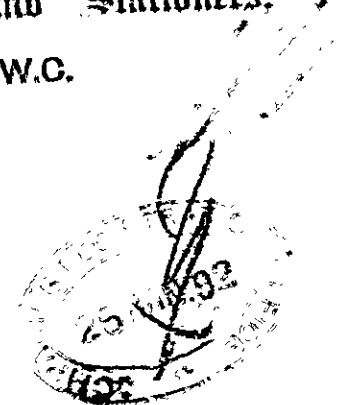

Memorandum of Association of the Everton Football Club and Athletic Grounds Company Limited

- 1 - The name of the Company is "The Everton Football Club and Athletic Grounds Company Limited."
- 2 - The registered office of the Company will be situated in England
- 3 - The objects for which the Company is established are:
  - (a) - To purchase take in lease or otherwise acquire the lands and hereditaments known as the Everton Football Ground together with the lands adjoining the same now belonging to Mr John Crull both of which are situate in Liverpool Road Liverpool in the County of Lancashire
  - (b) - To carry on the business of an Athletic Company in all its branches and in particular to buy out and prepare any lands for football, footballing and for any other kind of athletic sports recreation or entertainment and to construct stands, ladders and other erections, buildings and conveniences which may seem directly or indirectly conducive to the Company's objects and to contract hold and furnish the games of football, athletic sports, fish, game, tennis and other matches and otherwise to utilize the Company's property and rights and to give and contribute towards prizes, cups, shields and other rewards
  - (c) - To establish maintain and carry on any clubs or other conveniences in connection with the Company's property
  - (d) - To carry on any other business which may seem to the Company capable of being economically carried on in connection with the above or conducted directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or reimburse profitably any of the Company's property or rights
  - (e) - To acquire and utilize the whole or any part of the business property or liabilities of any person or Company carrying on any business which the Company is authorized to carry on or possessed of property suitable for the purposes of this Company.
  - (f) - To enter into any arrangement for sharing profits common interest or co-operation, joint adventure, reciprocal concession or otherwise with any person or Company carrying on or engaged in or about to carry on or engage in any business or transaction which this Company is authorized to carry on or engage in

or any business or transaction capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit this Company and to lend money to, to take or otherwise acquire shares or securities of any such Company and to sell, hold re-issue with or without guarantee or otherwise, deal with the same

191 To establish and support, or aid in the establishment and support of associations Institution funds trusts and conveniences calculated to benefit employees or ex-employees of the Company and to subscribe, or guarantee money for charitable or benevolent objects or for any exhibition or for any public general or useful object.

h Generally to purchase take or lease or in exchange hire or otherwise acquire any real and personal property and any rights or privileges which the Company may think necessary or convenient for the purposes of its business

i To invest and deal with the moneys of the Company not immediately required upon such securities and in such manner as may from time to time be determined

j To borrow or raise or secure the payment of money in such other manner as the Company shall think fit and in particular by the issue of debentures or debenture stock perpetual or otherwise charged upon all or any of the Company's property (both present and future) including its uncalled capital

k To draw make accept endorse discount execute and issue promissory notes bills of exchange and accounts of bankers and other negotiable or transferable instruments

l To sell, improve manage develop exchange lease mortgage dispose of turn to account or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property and rights of the Company

m To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects
